



BARN RULES

Our boarders are very important to CCF and we enjoy sharing the beauty of the farm with our boarders and their guests. Some rules are necessary to ensure the safety and happiness of all who use CCF facilities

1. CCF is a privately owned, family run equestrian facility. Our goal is to provide a positive, peaceful and harmonious environment for all boarders, guests and horses to enjoy. Gossip and other forms of negative energy will not be tolerated.
2. Proper riding helmets must be worn at all times while riding on CCF property.
3. CCF is a no smoking environment.
4. All riders and visitors must have a signed release on file.
5. Children must be supervised at all times.
6. For liability reasons, visitors are not allowed into the pastures to help retrieve a horse.
7. Be respectful of other boarders, other people's property and equipment.
8. Riding while intoxicated and using illegal substances on CCF property is not allowed.
9. Do not take CCF feed and hay without the knowledge of the barn manager.
10. Report any and all accidents to the barn manager and/or CCF owners as soon as they occur.
11. As a courtesy, disassemble jumps in riding arena as soon as you are finished with your ride/practice. Place disassembled jumps in one of the three corners (not the entry corner). Limit the number of jumps in the arena to three.
12. As a courtesy, schedule all lessons, vet and farrier appointments on the barn's lesson calendar at least 24 hours in advance.
13. As a courtesy, do not jump in arena while lessons are in progress.
14. No lessons will be scheduled for the arena on Sundays to allow full access to all boarders on that day.
15. As a courtesy, please clean up after yourself, especially in the wash rack area.
16. Turn barn lights off if you are the last person to leave in the evening.

17. Be aware of the barn cats and dogs while arriving and departing from the barn. The animals are often sleeping under or behind parked vehicles.
